**Dear Parents and Carers,**

We are delighted to share that our **Sports Day** will take place on **Tuesday 16th June 2026**. It may look a little different this year as we are introducing our **St Paul's Record Book**, where in each year group we will record for prosperity the child's that is the overall winner of each event.

Events will take place on the school field and promises to be a fun and active day for all pupils.

**Key Stage 1 children from :** 9:30am – 11:00am and **Key Stage 2 children :** 1:30pm – 3:00pm

**What will happen on the day...**

Children will take part in a carousel of five activity stations:

1. Javelin,
2. Hurdles
3. Sack race
4. Egg and spoon race
5. Bean bag throw

There will also be a shaded rest station with refreshments for the children. Each class will spend approximately 10 minutes at each activity before rotating to the next station. Achievements will be recorded at each station, and photographs and results will be added to year group floor books later that day when all the results are in. All children will receive a sticker for participation, and **certificates will be awarded during Celebration Worship later that week.**

At the end of the activities, children will take part in running races:

- Girls' races (split into Green & Red, then Blue & Yellow teams)
- Boys' races (split in the same way)

**Important information for the day:**

- Please ensure your child brings a **water bottle**
- Children should wear **appropriate sports clothing**
- If the weather is warm, please apply **suncream** before school and provide a **hat**.

**For parents attending:**

We warmly welcome parents to come and watch. For safety reasons:

- Parents should remain **along the fence surrounding the field**
- Please do not come onto the field or approach children during events

**End of the day arrangements:**

- **KS1 pupils** will return to class after the event as usual
- **KS2 pupils** will return to class to collect belongings and will be dismissed in the usual way at the end of the day

**Supporting all pupils:**

If your child may find a change in routine challenging, we recommend talking through the day in advance so they know what to expect. Practising events and clearly explaining expectations can help ensure a positive experience for all.

**If it is raining, we will notify all parents by 9.30am on the morning of the 16<sup>th</sup> July, we will still hold sports day but in the hall and take pictures, which we will put on class dojo, this is to ensure that we do not have to keep rearranging when children are excited about participating in the event. Unfortunately, the capacity for the hall will not accommodate parents and children for this, and although disappointing at least the children will be able to still participate.**
