The children will be attending the annual Harvest Festival to be held on Wednesday 4 October 2023 in St Paul's Church Hall beginning at 9.00am.

As you will be aware St Paul's Church is currently closed as it undergoes its scheduled building work.

Children should arrive to school for the normal time of 8.40am - 8.50am in time for morning registration wearing their full school uniform.

Parents, carers, extended family, and friends are also invited to attend this service. The children will remain seated with their class but there will be seating for family members.

This year it has been decided that the produce donated for our Harvest Festival will be donated to Lifted. 'Lifted' is the name for the justice initiatives across Church Wigan. This includes 6 Food Pantries and 2 Pop-Up Pantries, which are based across Wigan. There are more in the pipeline. The Pantries ensure that people can access low cost, nutritious food to feed themselves and their families. Pantries offer all who shop in them the dignity of choosing their own food in exchange for an annual membership fee of £5 and a suggested £3 per 15 item shop. Members can shop up to twice a week. The donations you bring will ensure that the pantries are well stocked in the weeks to come.

Lifted require items of food that can create a meal for a family and the following items would be ideal:

- Tinned potatoes
- Tinned vegetables
- Tinned meat
- Dried pasta
- Tinned curry
- Rice
- Tinned sponge pudding
- Tinned / Packet custard
- Tinned ravioli
- Tinned spaghetti
- Tea bags
- Coffee
- Dried milk.

Families would particularly be appreciative of donations of breakfast cereal.

If you could send your donated food item into school with your child on Wednesday 4 October 2023 or if you would like to bring a food item to the service with you if you are able to attend.
